

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 323

Approved August 14, 1972

WHEREAS, Edward A. McLaughlin, M.D., former State Director of Health, and a prominent practicing physician for more than one-half a century of his life span, has been called by Almighty God to his Eternal Reward, and

WHEREAS, Dr. McLaughlin's contribution in the area of public health service on the governmental level and as a voluntary member of various health agencies from the State, will long be remembered, notably among them being his affiliations with the Rhode Island Infantile Paralysis Foundation; the American Public Health Association; the Rhode Island Public Officials Association; membership on the Board of Directors of Blue Cross; Narragansett Council, Boy Scouts of America; Providence County Chapter National Infantile Paralysis Foundation; Providence Medical Society; the Rhode Island Medical Society; the American Medical Society, and the American Board of Preventive Medicine and Public Health, and

WHEREAS, Dr. McLaughlin, aside from his busy medical program, was prominent in various religious, social, and fraternal organizations such as the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick's, in which he held the presidency for a period of time; membership in the Sons of Irish Kings, the Harvard Club of Rhode Island, the Brown Club of Rhode Island, the Providence Lodge of Elks, and a Fourth Degree Member of the Knights of Columbus,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in noting with sincere regret the passing of Dr. Edward A. McLaughlin, His Honor, Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the Members of the City Council join with his legion of patients who benefited by his medical knowledge and those who profited by his social, fraternal, and religious contributions, and
