WHEREAS, The tragic shooting occurred within the Council Chambers of New York City Hall only moments before the Council Meeting began, and



WHEREAS, Councilman Davis formerly served as a New York City Police Officer; and devoted much of his life to nonviolence, being the founder of "Stop the Violence" marches in Brooklyn, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council resolves:
