Approved June 3, 1983

WHEREAS, Patrolman Milton Young, while on patrol, received a call over the radio, that a woman was standing on the catwalk of the Newport Bridge, and

WHEREAS, Patrolman Henry Lombardi, having arrived at the scene, attempted to dissuade the woman from jumping into the water, and

WHEREAS, Upon the woman slipping or attempting to jump, Patrolman Young risked his life by reaching out and holding onto her, avoiding a plunge into the water while Patrolman Lombardi wrapped his arms around one of Patrolman Young's legs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the City Council hereby unanimously commend Patrolman Milton Young and Patrolman Henry Lombardi for their heroic act of bravery and note that the Police Department of Newport, Rhode Island is indeed fortunate to have these courageous gentlemen as members of their force.
