WHEREAS, Said Act provides that federal and state highways passing through the City of Providence shall be maintained as State highways,

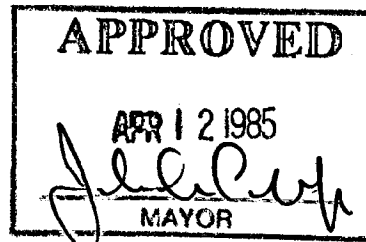

RELATING TO DECLARATION OF STATE
HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other act or state law, the
2 state director of transportation, by and through his designees, shall
3 be responsible for the maintenance costs, reconstruction, snow and ice
4 removal, construction, and maintenance of adjoining curbs and
5 sidewalks, drainage, and installation, and maintenance of traffic
6 signals on United States and Rhode Island roads passing through the
7 city of Providence as routes of travel for persons traveling from
8 other cities and towns or states as set forth in section 2 of this
9 act; and these public highways shall be henceforth designated as state
10 highways, as further defined in subsection 31-1-23(h) of the general
11 law as amended.

12 SECTION 2. The following lengths of United States and Rhode
13 Island routes within the city of Providence between the points of
14 crossing of the city lines, and being that width between the outside

1 boundaries of sidewalks abutting those routes, are hereby declared to
2 be state highways:

3 U.S. route 1 from the Elmwood avenue intersection with the
4 Cranston city line through the city of Providence to its intersection
5 on North Main street with the Pawtucket city line;

6 U.S. route 1A from the Cranston city line along the Narragansett
7 boulevard and Allens avenue to the intersection of Allens avenue and
8 Eddy street;

9 U.S. Route 6 from the intersection of South Main street and
10 Wickenden street along Promenade street to Hartford avenue to its
11 intersection with the Johnston town line;

12 U.S. route 44 from the intersection of South Main street and
13 Wickenden along North Main street and Smith street along Smith street
14 to its intersection with the North Providence town line;

15 State route 2 from the intersection of Elmwood avenue and Broad
16 street and Elmwood avenue to its intersection with the Cranston city
17 line;

18 State route 7 from the intersection of Charles and Orms streets
19 along Charles street along Douglas avenue to its intersection with the
20 North Providence line;

21 State route 117 from the Cranston city line along Broad street to
22 the intersection of U.S. route 1 at Elmwood avenue;

23 State route 14 along Plainfield street at intersection with the
24 Johnston city line to its intersection with Hartford avenue;

25 State route 128 along Killingly street from its intersection with
26 the Johnston city line to its intersection with Plainfield street;

27 State route 126 along Silver Spring street from its intersection
28 with Charles street to its intersection with the Pawtucket city line;

29 State route 246 along Charles street from its intersection with
30 the North Providence city line to its intersection with Mill street.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1985.
