

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 360

Approved July 19, 1976

WHEREAS, during the early morning hours of July 7, 1976, the Providence Fire Department was alerted and responded to the call of a fire in the building located at the corner of Union Avenue and Pocasset Avenue and numbered 308 Pocasset Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the Officers and Men of the Department, proceeded to control, contain and extinguish that major fire, thus preventing it from spreading onto abutting structures, which undoubtedly saved thousands of dollars in property damages and the possible loss of lives, in that immediate area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in commending the Members of the Providence Fire Department who responded to that fire, the residents of that immediate area are not unmindfull of the efficient manner which these brave fire-fighters extinguished that major fire, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk, upon the passage of this Resolution by the City Council and its Approval by His Honor the Mayor, is directed to cause a duly engrossed copy thereof, to be transmitted to Chief Michael F. Moise, that he may in turn, make the Department cognizant of the respect and esteem the Fire Department is held by the Citizens of the City of Providence.
