


To the Honorable City Council:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency hereby petitions the Providence City Council to consider the abandonment of Holbrook Street, a portion of Crescent Street, Lawton Street, Crins Street and a portion of Downing Street.

As shown on the attached plan, Holbrook Street, a portion of Crescent Street, Lawton Street and Crins Street are within the former Gorham manufacturing site. They were platted but not accepted. The City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on Tuesday, November 20, 2001 reviewed and evaluated the communication of the Committee on Public Works dated October 25, 2001 requesting the Commission's recommendation on the proposed abandonment of Holbrook Street, a portion of Crescent Street, Lawton Street, Crins Street, a portion of Downing Street and a portion of Alvin St. The petitioner is the Providence Redevelopment Agency. The abandonments are requested for the redevelopment of the former Gorham manufacturing facility.

The Commission made the following findings of fact as required by the *City Plan Commission Handbook* Policy No. 1: "Criteria and Guidelines for Approval of Street, Highway and Rights-of-way Abandonment":

- 1. A public interest has to be clearly demonstrated. A public interest is defined as one or more of the following: public health and safety, adequate provision of transportation, general improvement of traffic patterns and/or circulation, convenient access to properties, avoidance of a nuisance, significant economic development, preservation of a historical or cultural feature, and improvement of the general welfare of the community.*

These street abandonments are in the public interest as they will further the redevelopment of an abandoned industrial site. As these streets were never opened, there will be no adverse impact on traffic patterns.

2. *No negative impact is evident on existing land uses, future plans, zoning, safety, health or welfare of the community by the proposed abandonment.*

No negative impacts from these abandonments are anticipated.

3. *All abutting landowners agree to the proposed abandonment.*

The PRA is the abutter in all cases.

4. *No physical or legal access will be denied to any land or property in surrounding areas by the proposed abandonment.*

No access will be denied to surrounding areas.

5. *No existing or future public services or facilities need to be protected, provided, or maintained within the right-of-way. An easement retention may be necessary to provide access to, maintain, or provide existing or future service or utility needs.*

No existing or future public services or facilities need to be protected, provided, or maintained within the rights-of-way.

6. *The proposed or intended use of the street and/or adjacent properties must be shown on a petition or plan, and such use shall be in conformance with existing zoning and Comprehensive Plan Objectives.*

A petition and plan have been provided. This proposal is consistent with the Zoning Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan.

The Commission voted to recommend to the Committee on Public Works that it approve the subject abandonments.






