

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The traffic around the Gilbert Stuart Elementary School is congested and motorists travel at a speed which exceeds the normal limits for a school zone, and

WHEREAS, Three children have been struck and injured by automobiles within the area, and

WHEREAS, The Providence Police Department has issued more than seventy traffic violations within a three week period in the same area, and

WHEREAS, The parents of Gilbert Stuart Elementary School students have formed a group of concerned citizens which is working with the Providence School Department, the Police Department and the Traffic Engineering Department, and

WHEREAS, A large number of the students from Gilbert Stuart Elementary School enter and exit the building from the Bucklin Street side,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby endorses the closing of Bucklin Street at the time when students are entering and exiting the building and requests the Traffic Engineer to survey the area for the possible daily closing of Bucklin Street between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the staff and visitors of the West End Community Center have access to the center during the times that Bucklin Street is closed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer cause crosswalks to be painted/repainted at all intersections surrounding the Gilbert Stuart Elementary School, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer cause the installation of appropriate traffic signs indicating that Bucklin Street is closed during the times mentioned.
