No. 227 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION  
OF CERTAIN QUESTIONS TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY.

Approved May 6, 1960

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. The Secretary of State is hereby requested to submit the following questions to the qualified electors of the City of Providence at the special election to be held for the State of Rhode Island on Tuesday, May 19, 1960 or at such other date as the Governor of the State of Rhode Island may designate, but if no special election is held prior to the General Election in 1960, then to the electors at the General Election to be held November 8, 1960:

1. Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00) Dollars for sewer purposes?
2. Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars for highway purposes?
3. Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars for the acquisition and/or improvement of public parks, playgrounds and recreation facilities, including the purchase or condemnation of land for such purposes?

Sec. 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit to the Secretary of State forthwith upon the passage of this ordinance a certified copy thereof.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE 1946 REVISED ORDINANCES RELATIVE  
TO COMMISSIONERS OF SINKING FUNDS.

Approved May 6. 1960

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. Sections 48 and 51 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence (1946) are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 48. Custody of securities and books of account.

The Treasurer of the Board of Commissioners of Sinking Funds shall have custody of and shall deposit all securities of said Board in a bank or trust Company approved by the Finance Committee of the City Council.

The Treasurer shall obtain at least quarterly from said bank or trust company a statement of all such securities so deposited, together with a list of all securities purchased or sold since the previous statement.

Sec. 51. Bonds not to be negotiable except by order of board.

All securities which shall be purchased by the Board of Commissioners of Sinking Funds may be in either registered or bearer form. Such securities shall not be sold, exchanged or redeemed except by order of said board.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

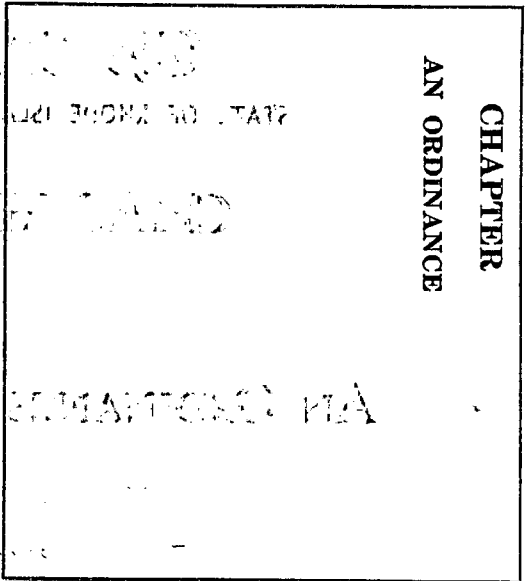
