

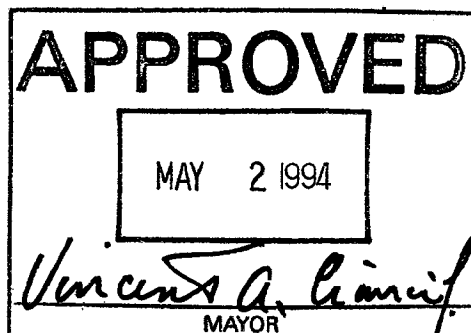
WHEREAS, It has become a dangerous situation at the corner of Detroit Avenue and Niagara Street where there are three light poles located, and
