The following is a brief outline of my background:

Attended Mount Pleasant High School and graduated in June, 1945. Enlisted in U.S. Coast Guard in June, 1945 and received an honorable discharge in July, 1946 at the convenience of the government.

Enrolled in Bryant College in 1946 for two years in Accounting & Finance. In 1948, enrolled in the R.I. School of Design in Architecture for 2½ years. An opening was then offered me with the Division of Architecture and Engineering in the State House in Rhode Island. The following duties I performed in the 5½ years with the state:

Prepared plans and specifications for all repairs and alterations for 32 buildings owned by the State of Rhode Island.

Coordinated and supervised the construction inspector's responsibility to control all contracts in progress.

Reviewed all plans and specifications for all new buildings to be put out for bidding for the State of Rhode Island.

In 1956, I left the State of Rhode Island and went to work for Charles A. McGuire & Associates, which was an opportunity to broaden my knowledge and experience in Engineering.
