Dear Mr. Whelan:

Acknowledgement is made of the receipt of a copy of Resolution No. 430 of the City Council approved July 11, 1963.

Under Rhode Island Contract No. 6375 in connection with construction of Interstate Route 95 near the Providence-Pawtucket city line, the following sentence under the heading, "Objectionable Material", is quoted:

"No method of disposal will be started until the entire area containing this objectionable material will have been protected by an approved method of insect and rodent control through the Warfarin process and in accordance with the requirements of the city or town in which the work is being performed."

As you can see, it is the intention of the State Department of Public Works to provide effective rodent control at the site of construction of Route 95 near the Providence-Pawtucket line.

It is understood that the contractor now has an exterminator at work in the area, and that sanitarians attached to the City of Pawtucket Department of Health are watching carefully the results of his work in adjacent areas of Pawtucket. Perhaps, sanitarians employed by the City of Providence Department of Health can keep a similar watch on the nearby Providence areas.

While the State Department of Health operates under no specific legal direction for statewide rodent control, nonetheless the department is concerned with this problem. You may be sure that the department will look into any reports of the failure of the contractor to carry out the terms of his contract as they relate to rodent control.

To the Honorable the City Council of Providence

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to report to your Honorable Body on the subject of a resolution requesting the establishment of a police foot patrol beat in the Webster-Pocasset Avenues area. A detailed study was made of this area by the Police Department Administrative Staff Division. The study indicates, and so recommends, that a foot patrol beat is neither required or desirable at this time.

At the present time a patrol car covers this beat and appears to be adequately patrolling the area. Few other posts have a smaller number of police incidents, and there appears to be no demonstrated need for a foot post.

Since the deployment of police forces is constantly under study, the department will review the situation in this area at a future date. It may then determine that a change may be needed.

To the Honorable the City Council of Providence

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to report to your Honorable Body that an investigation was made as requested in a resolution of the City Council in the matter of a possible violation of Chapter 1122 of the Ordinances as to unreasonable noise.

Hillwood Street begins at the end of Whitehall Street just east of Union Avenue and ends in Cranston. The Procaccini Trucking Company, owned by Fred Procaccini of 380 Farmington Avenue, Cranston, utilizes parking space on his property which fronts at 230 Union Avenue. He owns three tractor-trailer trucks and has been parking them at this location since last February. The trucks leave the parking area at about 6:30 a.m. daily and return at about 4:30 p.m. No loading, unloading or repairing of said trucks takes place at the parking area. Upon leaving and returning to the aforesaid parking area the trucks proceed a very short distance on Hillwood Street to Whitehall Street to Union Avenue.

No evidence was observed to indicate that the provisions of Chapter 1122 of the Providence ordinances were violated. The only noise incidence of this operation occurs as a result of the normal operation of these trucks.

It appears from the investigation that there is no violation of Chapter 1122. (*Ordinances of 1942*)


