This office has under consideration the application of New England Telephone & Telegraph Co., 234 Washington Street, Providence, R. I.

for a State of Rhode Island assent to lay and maintain an additional armored telephone submarine cable to the south of the Washington Bridge between Providence and East Providence, R. I., proposed cable to be placed at a depth of 23 feet below MLW between fenders and 50 feet on each side of fenders; from each shore cable to be buried 3 feet below natural bottom; cable to be 6 feet south of an existing cable in Seekonk River

at Providence and East Providence, R. I.

Plans of the proposed work may be seen at this office.

You are advised that if you have good reason to enter protests against the proposed work it is your privilege to do so. It is expected that objectors will review the application and plans thoroughly, visit site of proposed work if necessary to familiarize themselves with the conditions and cite what law or laws, if any, would in their opinion be violated by the work proposed.
