

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Resolved,

That the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the Office of the Department of Building Inspection subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated and further provided that the Director of the Department of Building Inspection may authorize minor changes in the structural detail of plans on file, viz:

Mobil Oil Corporation 765-775 Cranston Street and 454 Huntington Avenue, Plat 42, Lots 14, 78, 344, 411, construct Gasoline Service Station and install Three (3) Four Thousand (4,000) Gallon Gasoline Tanks, One (1) Five Hundred (500) Gallon Fuel Oil Tank; a Total Capacity of Twelve Thousand (12,000) Gallons Gasoline, Five Hundred (500) Gallon Fuel Oil Tank; six (6) Gasoline Filling Pumps; Making a Total Capacity of Twelve Thousand (12,000) Gallons Gasoline, Five Hundred (500) Gallon Waste Oil and Five Hundred (500) Gallon Fuel Tanks Oil Upon the Premises.

The erection or location of any buildings or structures not shown on the original plat on file with the Director of Department of Building Inspection, or any change in the location of buildings or structures from that shown on said plat shall be deemed a violation of this permit.





RE: Proposed Abandonment of a Portion of Hyacinth Street (so Called)

In regards to the proposed abandonment of a portion of Hyacinth Street (so called) it might be advisable to get a legal opinion from the City Solicitor as to who has the fee in Hyacinth Street.

On June 12, 1917, the City Council by Resolution #240, authorized the purchase from the Wanskuck Company of an area to be used for playground purposes. It is specified in the deed that the land abuts a proposed street, 38' wide to be called Hyacinth Street and a proposed street, 40' wide to be called Shiloh Street.

These streets have never been recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds as public Highways, but have been used as such for many years, possibly in the category of a private street.

The Tax Assessor's Office has shown Hyacinth and Shiloh Streets on their plats ever since the purchase by the City of the playground area.

This referral is a petition to abandon that portion of Hyacinth Street from the southwesterly line of Harwol Court to Veazie Street on Assessor's Plat 102.


A photographic and inspection survey revealed that the section of Hyacinth Street in question is uncurbed and unpaved.



RE: Proposed Abandonment of a Portion of Hyacinth Street (so Called)

In regards to the proposed abandonment of a portion of Hyacinth Street (so called) it might be advisable to get a legal opinion from the City Solicitor as to who has the fee in Hyacinth Street.

On June 12, 1917, the City Council by Resolution #240, authorized the purchase from the Wanskuck Company of an area to be used for playground purposes. It is specified in the deed that the land abuts a proposed street, 38' wide to be called Hyacinth Street and a proposed street, 40' wide to be called Shiloh Street.

These streets have never been recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds as public Highways, but have been used as such for many years, possibly in the category of a private street.

The Tax Assessor's Office has shown Hyacinth and Shiloh Streets on their plats ever since the purchase by the City of the playground area.

This referral is a petition to abandon that portion of Hyacinth Street from the southwesterly line of Harwol Court to Veazie Street on Assessor's Plat 102.


A photographic and inspection survey revealed that the section of Hyacinth Street in question is uncurbed and unpaved.
