

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 93

Approved February 17, 1975

WHEREAS, the Royal Roost Restaurant, so-called, located in the Providence Civic Center is open for public business, only on days when events are scheduled at the said Center, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the City of Providence is deprived of its share of revenue under the provisions of its lease from said restaurant, since it is currently operating on a limited basis,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Providence Civic Center Authority is requested to submit a copy of its contract with Araserv, Inc. to the Committee on Finance of the City Council, that the said Committee may investigate the authority of Araserv, Inc. to operate said restaurant on a limited time basis, thus depriving the City of Providence of sorely needed revenue from its' lease.
