
Gentlemen:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause "No Thru Traffic" signs to be posted along Leslie Drive, at its' intersections with Mount Pleasant Avenue, the purpose for such signs is to prohibit motor vehicles along said Leslie Drive, with the exception of local motor vehicle traffic and local deliveries from motor vehicles.
