Approved October 22, 1996

WHEREAS, This is more likely to happen in women over the age of fifty and who have other family with breast cancer, and

WHEREAS, The good news is that nearly nine (9) out of ten (10) women could survive this deadly killer, if they follow the stay alert, which is:


1. Check your breasts monthly.
2. Age 20 - 40: Have a healthcare professional check your breasts every 3 years.
3. Age 40: Have your first mammogram (breast x-ray).
4. Over age 50: Have a healthcare professional check your breasts every year and have a mammogram every year, and

WHEREAS, Too many women die each year from cancer, such as cancers of the breast, lung, uterus, colon, or rectum, which are the most common cancers that attack women.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the Providence City Council, do hereby proclaim October, 1996 Breast Cancer Month in the City of Providence, Rhode Island, and hope that all women have their breasts checked regularly.
