Dear Mr. Brooks:

It has been learned that an error exists in the salary ordinance for the position of Fire Equipment Superintendent II which was approved retroactively to July 1, 1987.

The salary under the "from" column of the ordinance indicates a salary of 40,441.96 and should have read 43,508.00 from the amendment of Chapter 1987-20 approved June 25, 1987 and repealing Chapter 1986-32 approved June 26, 1986 as amended. That ordinance carried a salary for the Fire Equipment Superintendent II of 43,508.00. As a result of this error (40,441.96) it created a disproportioned increase in subsequent raises.

In view of this and the fact that according to the Finance Department, an amended ordinance is being introduced to increase other inequities in the salary account, it is requested that the salary of the Fire Equipment Superintendent II in the ordinance that was approved retroactive to July 1, 1987 be amended to make the Fire Equipment Superintendent II salary 43,508.00 to 48,508.00 and that the ordinance effective July 1, 1988 change the salary from 48,508.00 to 50,885.00.
