## CHAPTER 842

No. 154 AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION

OF A PROVIDENCE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION.

Approved April 1, 1954

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. A commission, to be known as the Providence Industrial Commission, is hereby created, consisting of five qualified electors of the City of Providence, to be appointed by the Mayor and to serve at his pleasure. Members of said commission shall be representative of labor, management and such other interests as may be deemed necessary or desirable. Vacancies of said commission shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments were made. Said commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be allowed such necessary travel or incidental expense, as shall be consistent with its requirements and within the appropriation provided by ~~this~~ ordinance. Said commission shall appoint a secretary who shall not be a member thereof, and who shall serve without compensation.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of said commission to study and advise on the most practical approach to community industry development problems, including examination of such factors as would interest and attract industrialists or others who might be seeking an industrial plant site with the purpose of encouraging industry and employment in the City of Providence. In the exercise of the foregoing duty, said commission shall co-operate to the fullest possible extent with the Development Council of the State of Rhode Island.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

**No. 155 AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 776 BY APPROPRIATING ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000) DOLLARS TO AN ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS "PROVIDENCE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION ACCOUNT".

*Approved* April 1, 1954

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1: Chapter 776 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1953, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$29,679,752.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1954", is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars to an Account to be known as PROVIDENCE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION ACCOUNT.

SECTION 2: The sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars is hereby appropriated; said amount to be charged to the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

SECTION 3: The sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 4: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
