# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Scholastic aptitude Test Scores for the City of Providence, among its high school students, are comparatively low to the rest of the secondary school systems in the State of Rhode Island, and

WHEREAS, The Providence School Committee is attempting to rectify this most serious problem by remedial teaching and tutoring, and

WHEREAS, The system of education in the City of Providence is of such serious nature,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence, pursuant to Title 16, Chapter 1, Section 4(d) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, requests the State Department of Education, through the Board of Regents, to review the subjects and courses of study being taught and the instructional standards being used in the elementary and secondary schools in the City of Providence, and make necessary recommendations, and to further direct the Commissioner of Education to review and recommend subjects and courses of study and instructional standards, where necessary for the elementary and secondary schools in the City of Providence subject to Title 16, Chapter 1, Section 5 (d) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, so as to see that the best education is given the children of the City of Providence.
