No. 139 **AN ORDINANCE** CREATING A DEPARTMENT OF
COMMUNICATIONS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Approved March 10, 1971

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2723 of the Public Laws of 1951, there is hereby created in the City of Providence, a Department of Communications within the Department of Public Safety.

The Department of Communications shall have jurisdiction over all designing, procuring installation and operation of all municipal radio, telephone, teletype and other associated equipment.

SECTION 2. Appointment of Director. The Director of the Department of Communications shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the City Council, and shall hold office at the pleasure of the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Rules and Regulations. The Director is hereby empowered to make and to adopt such written rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance, but no such rules and regulations shall be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, or shall have the effect of waving any of the provisions of this Ordinance provided, also, that said rules and regulations do not conflict with any rule or regulation of the Department of Public Safety.

Communications Division in all of its phases. He is ultimately responsible for designing, procuring, installation and proper operation of all municipal radio, telephone, teletype, and other associated equipment.

He delegates authority to his subordinates as necessary for the smooth operation of the Division. He maintains close liaison with other City Departments and provides them with technical advice and specifications for procurement of new equipment. He performs related work as may be assigned him by the Mayor or the City Council.

SECTION 6. Reports of Director. The Director shall annually, in the month of January, submit a report to the Mayor and to the City Council regarding the activities of the Department of Communications for the prior fiscal year.

SECTION 9. Conflict with other Ordinances. In any case where the provisions of this Ordinance or any regulation adopted pursuant thereto is found to be in conflict with the provisions of any ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation of the City of Providence, the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply.

SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage , and all ordinances or resolutions, rules or regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 1. COMMUNICATIONS: DIRECTOR

DUTIES: This employee is responsible for the complete operation of the Communications Division in all of its phases. He is ultimately responsible for designing, procuring, installation and proper operation of all municipal radio, telephone, teletype and other associated equipment.

He delegates authority to his subordinates as necessary for the smooth operation of the Division. He maintains close liaison with other City Departments and provides them with technical advice and specifications for procurement of new equipment. He performs related work as may be assigned him by the Mayor or the City Council.

QUALIFICATIONS: Supervisory and administrative capabilities are a must. He must have a minimum of ten (10) years experience in the field of modern communications which should include: System design of Radio, Telegraph, Telephone or other communications equipment. He should have at least five (5) years experience in drawing specifications for Radio equipment, Telephone equipment, Cable and Wire as used in the municipal system. He should have a minimum of a 2nd Class FCC License and at least a Journeymans Electrical license issued by the State of R.I.. A complete working knowledge of the Underground Cable plant and the Aerial portion of the Cities Communications System is necessary. He must be thoroughly familiar with all pertinent City, State and Federal Codes and directives of other agencies such as FCC etc.

That the Building Code of the City of Providence, Chapter 1079, approved December 21, 1956, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding Section 128.45, to read as follows:

Section 1.

Sec. 128.45 - Filings Fees - Any appeal to the Building Board of Review or any petition for a variance or modification of the Building Ordinance shall be accompanied by a filing fee of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars which shall be deposited with the City Collector and no part thereof shall be returnable to the petitioner.
