Be It Ordained By The City Of Providence:

Section 1. The sum of Eight Million, Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,778,000.00) shall be borrowed for the purpose of slum clearance and redevelopment. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue Eight Million, Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,778,000.00) Public Improvement Bonds pursuant to Chapter 220 of the Public Laws of 1968 and subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.
