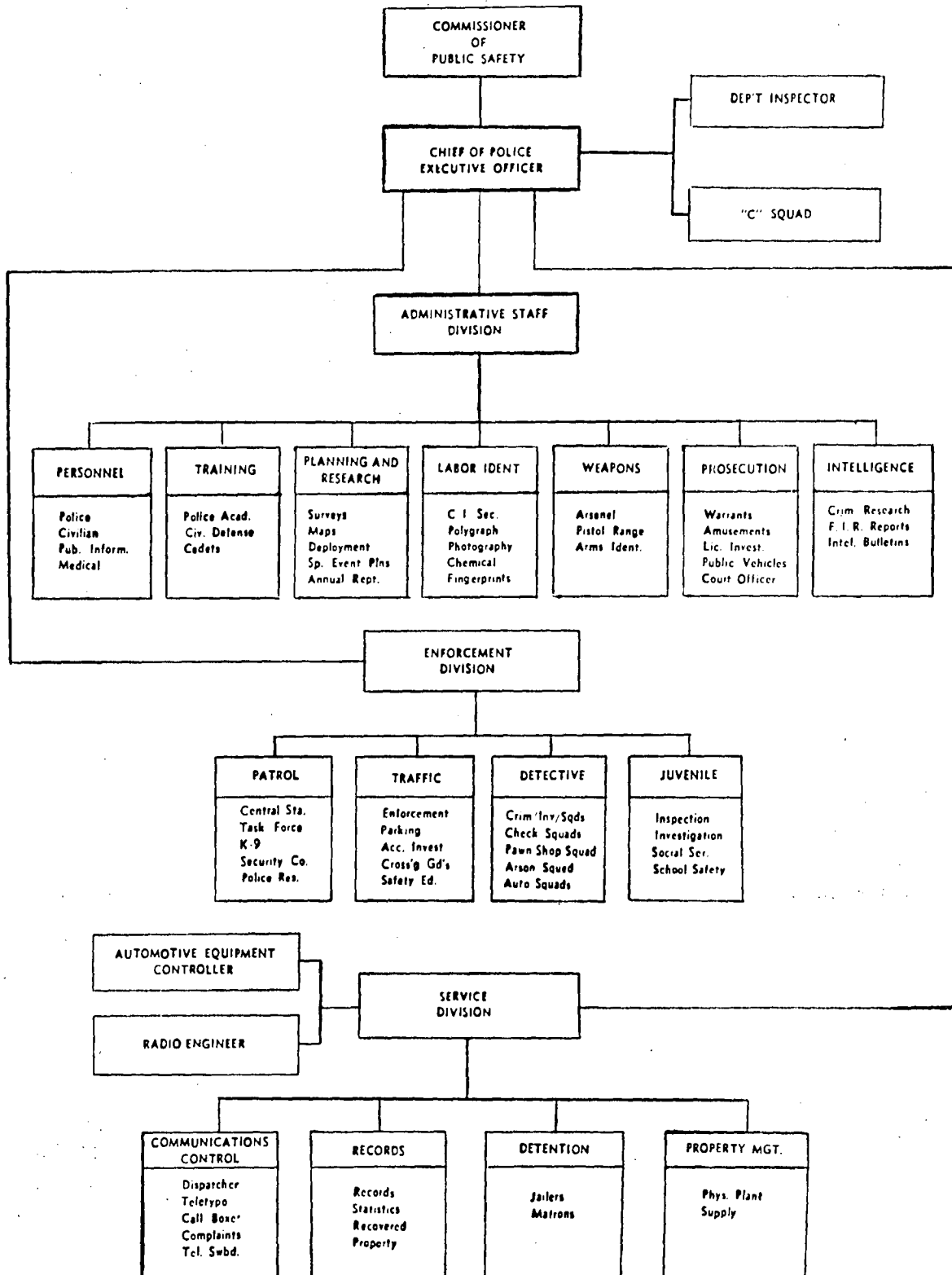
In the year 1967 we will continue our dedicated course as outlined by your policies to protect life, property, and the rights of the citizens of our community.

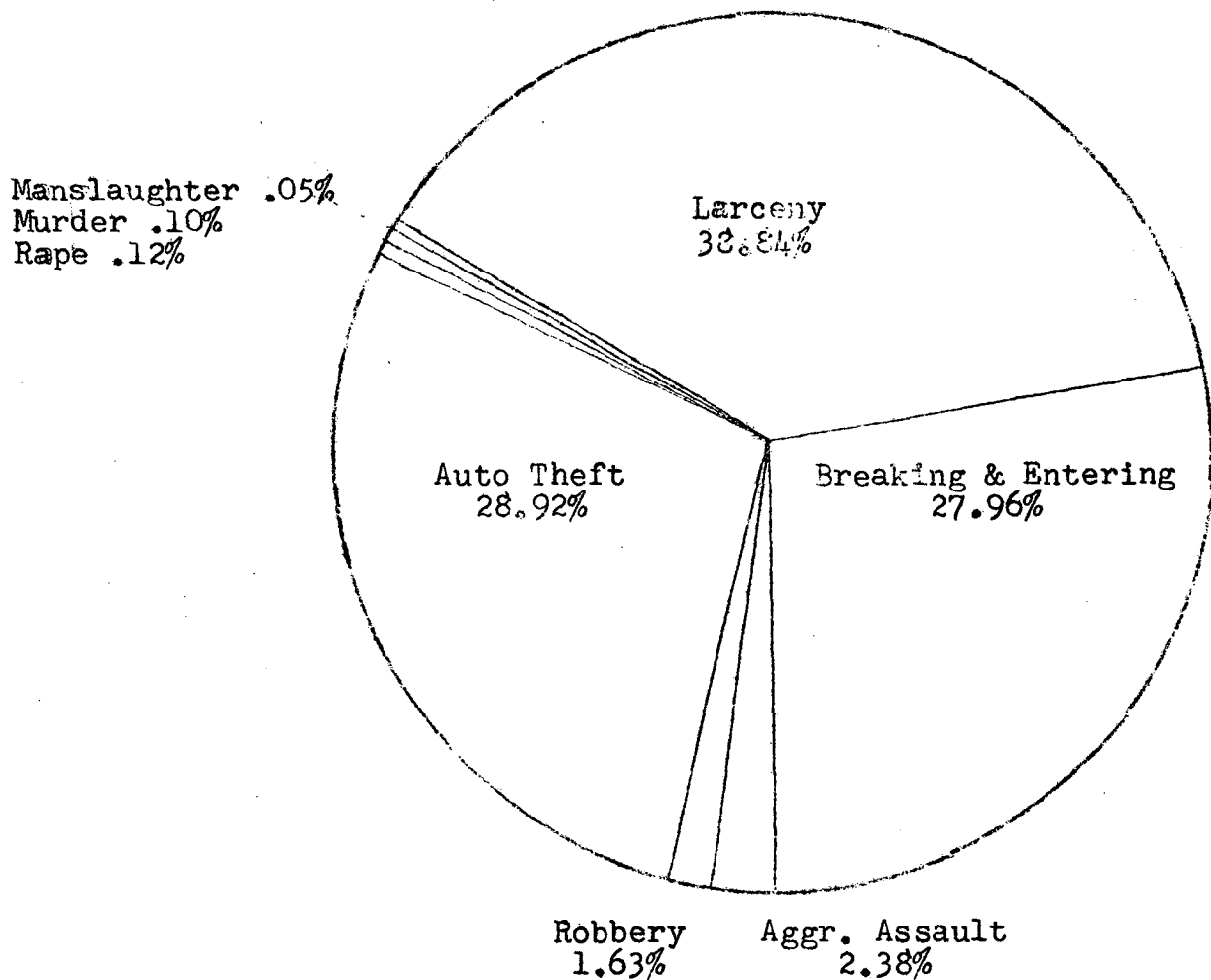

## ANALYSIS OF PART I OFFENSES

### UNIFORM CRIME CLASSIFICATION

The most predominant category of Part I crimes occurring in the City of Providence during 1966 was Larceny which occurred at the rate of 10+ offenses per day. There were 50.6 Part I offenses per 1000 Population which occurred at the rate of one offense every 55.1 minutes.



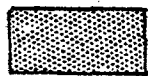
PART I OFFENSES  
1966



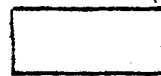
CLEARANCE OF PART I OFFENSES REPORTED TO THE POLICE

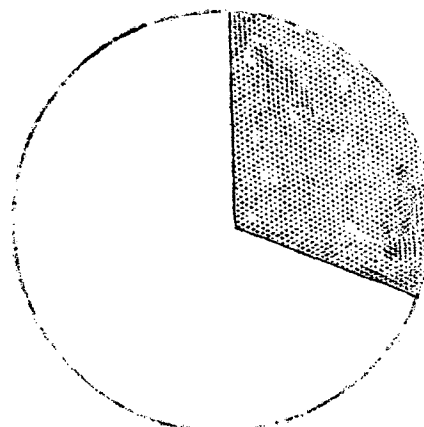

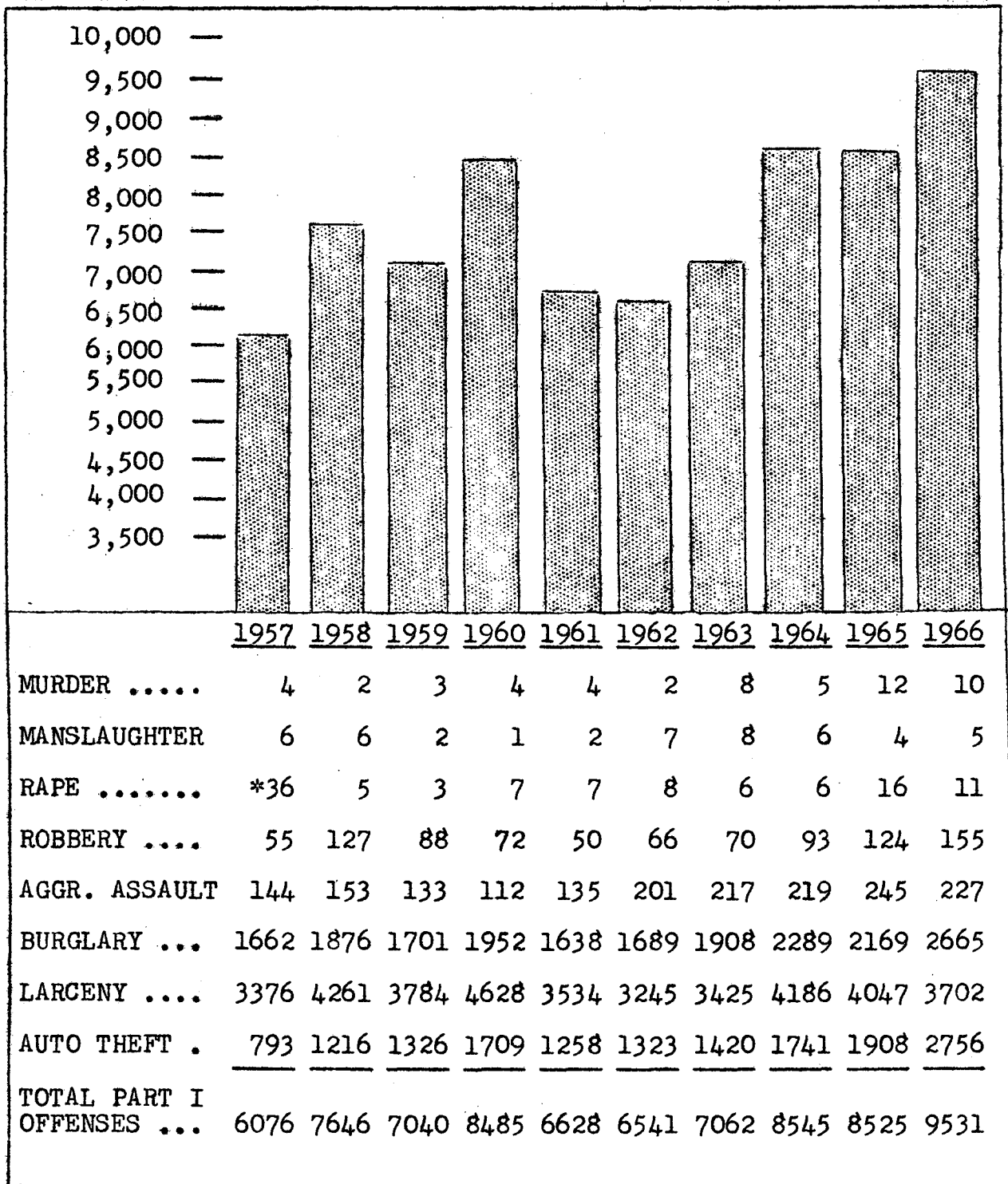

PART I OFFENSES 1957 - 1966



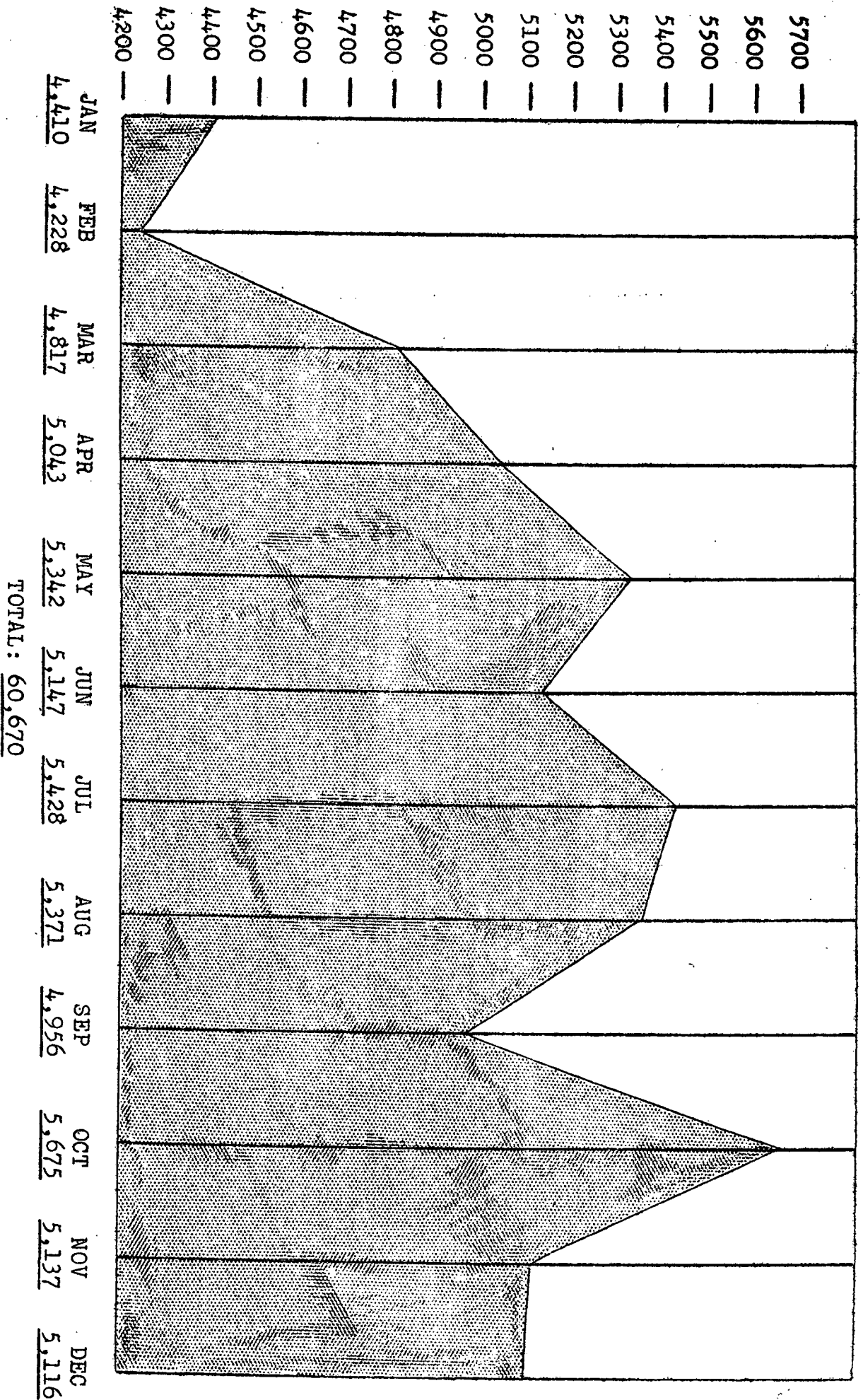

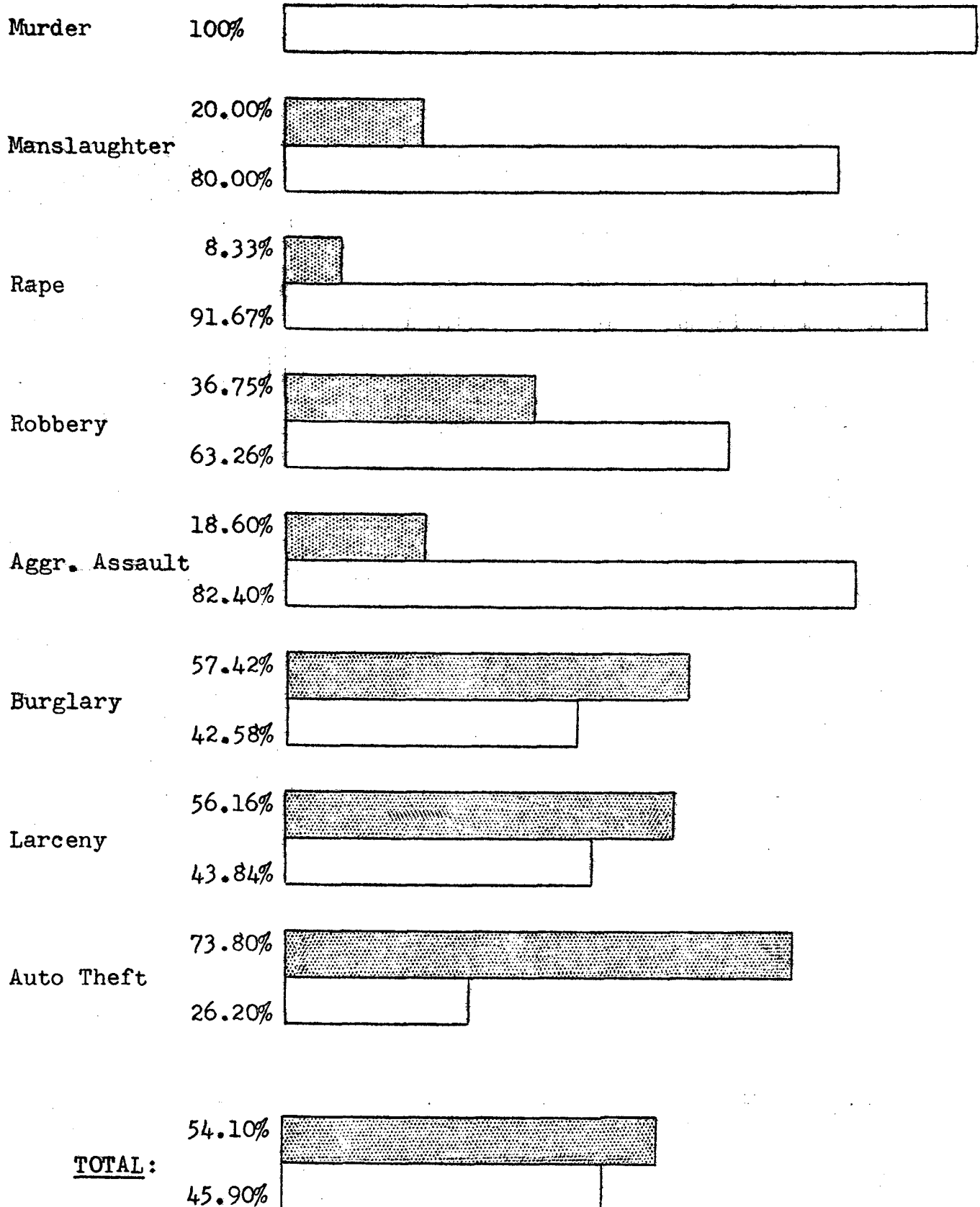

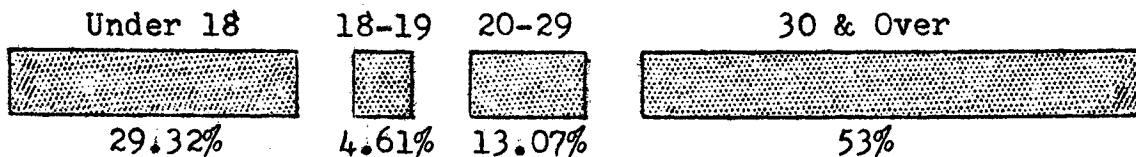


## COMPARISON OF POPULATION AGE GROUPS TO ARREST AGE GROUPS

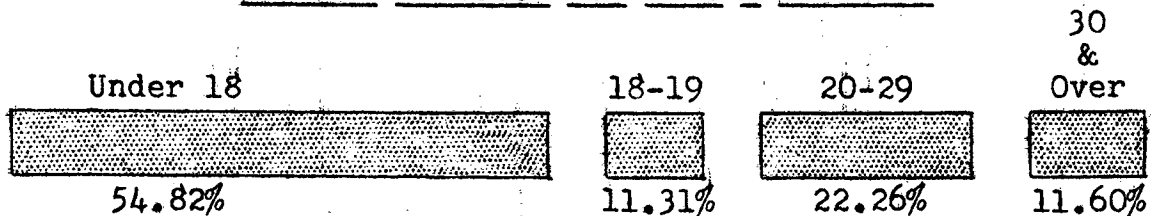

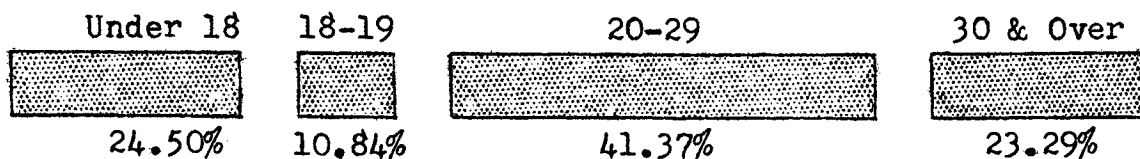
### Providence Population by Age Group



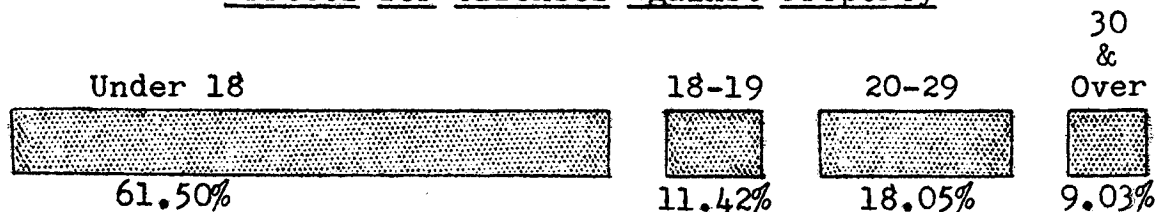
### Persons Arrested for Part I Offenses
