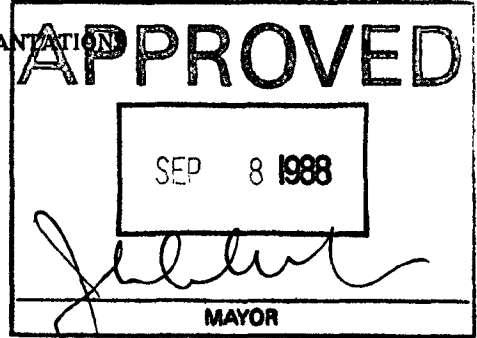

No. 416 AN ORDINANCE Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1988-6, approved January 26, 1988.

Approved September 8, 1988

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The number of employees in the Water Supply Board Administration shall not exceed fourteen (14). There shall be no more than:
