RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 526

Approved August 12, 1983

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROVIDENCE HOME RULE CHARTER, OF ALL BUT APPROXIMATELY 2½ ACRES OF THAT LAND IN NARRAGANSETT, RHODE ISLAND KNOWN AS CAMP CRONIN, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION #296 APPROVED MAY 7, 1956.

1. RESOLVED That pursuant to section 416 of the City Charter, the Committee on City Property is authorized to take all of the steps and actions required by the City Charter for the sale of that real estate of the City situated in the Town of Narragansett, Rhode Island, consisting of approximately 29.8 acres (being the greater part of the Camp Cronin property so-called), the City retaining ownership of approximately 2½ acres of the said Camp Cronin which is now or lately used for recreational or educational purposes, as described and delineated on the attached sketch or drawing prepared by the Providence Department of Public Works dated October 15, 1981.
2. RESOLVED further, that any public notice published pursuant to Section 416(1) shall contain provisions that all bids shall be sealed; that any and all bids may be rejected by the said Committee and the property may be re-advertised or it may be removed from the market; and that no bid shall be deemed accepted by the City until the same is subsequently approved by the City Council, in conformance with the City Charter.
3. RESOLVED further, that 20 years having elapsed since the City acquired said property by deed of June 10, 1957, and condition no. 1 in said deed having been fulfilled as to the use of the property "for public park purposes and for a public recreational area, for incidental purposes relating thereto," Resolution No. 296 of this City Council approved May 7, 1956 is hereby amended accordingly, and this Council further declares and resolves that the said portion of

the said property being authorized for sale herein is no longer needed nor desirable for any of the said purposes by the City of Providence (i.e. public park, public recreational area, or for incidental purposes relating thereto.)
