
Dear Madam Clerk

I would like this letter to clarify the intention of the Mayor in submitting appointments to the City Council relative to the Providence Civic Center Authority.

The terms of Mr. Addison and Mr. Ricci had expired in May of 1990. It was clearly the intention of the Mayor to appoint Mr. Weiner to the vacancy created by the expiration of Mr. Addison's term, to appoint Mr. Ricci to a new term to expire in May of 1993, and to appoint Mr. Addison to the unexpired term of Mr. Weiner.

It appears that there was some confusion with the City Council on this matter, and I hope that this letter and the attachments to such will clearly state Mayor Paolino's intent for your records.



INTER-OFFICE MEMO

ISSUE: Under Section 1104 of the Providence Home Rule Charter, does the Mayor's appointment of a member of the Providence Civic Center Authority require the approval of the City Council to be effective?

OPINION: No.

DISCUSSION

In regards to the Providence Civic Center Authority, the Home Rule Charter states:

- (a) The authority shall consist of seven (7) members, five (5) of whom shall be appointed by the mayor... see Section 1104.

Unlike other sections of the Charter (i.e., Sec. 1103 Human Rights Commission; Sec. 1102 Board of Licenses, etc.), the power to appoint a member is not subject to "the approval of the city council." Upon articulation by the mayor, an appointment to the Civic Center Authority becomes effective.

The acceptance or a rejection of a communication from the mayor to the city council advising the latter of an appointment is merely for informational purposes only. The rejection of a communication advising the city council of an appointment to the Civic Center Authority does not effect the legality of an appointment.



Dear Chairman Goodman:

As you know, the Civic Center Authority is a very important agency of our City. In May of 1990, I had the opportunity to make two appointments to the Board of the Civic Center Authority. There has been some confusion as to those appointments and I wanted this letter to serve as clarification to you relative to those appointments.

Upon the expiration of Philip Addison's term, I appointed Mark Weiner to a three year term. Simultaneously, I appointed Mr. Addison to fill the balance of Mr. Weiner's unexpired term. This matter has been discussed with the City Solicitor, Edward Clifton and counsel to the Authority, Karen Ellsworth. They agree with my staff that these appointments are in order and do not require council ratification. I hope this clarifies this matter for the Civic Center Authority Board Members.
