

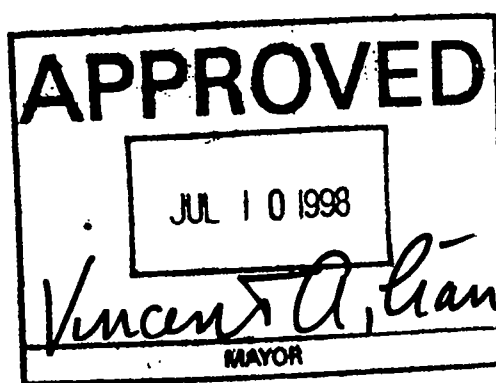

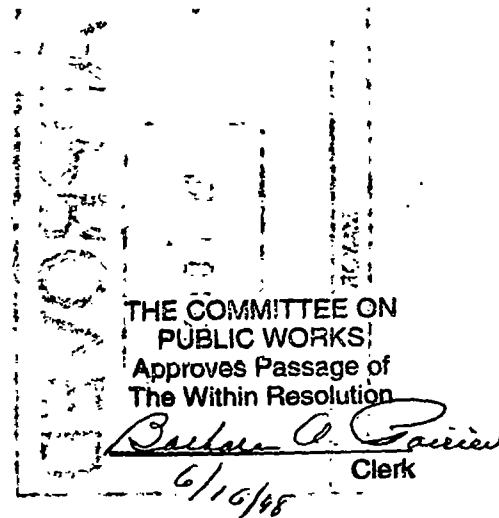

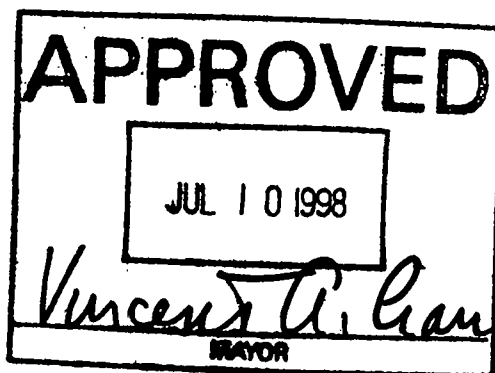

To Whom It May Concern:

For Safety Purposes and to avoid accidents, a concerned citizen of Providence presents this matter to you.

The two streets where an accident may happen are:

Atwells Avenue and Harris Avenue.

On Atwells Avenue - and Harris Avenue ---- at this corner, there is no sign or arrow for a right turn going up the hill or down the hill. So the cars form these two lanes - and when the light changes, the cars dive ahead from these lanes. The cars try to outdo each other-- no courtesy is shown. The same thing happens coming down the hill - no arrow or sign to take a left turn.

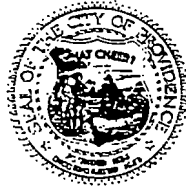

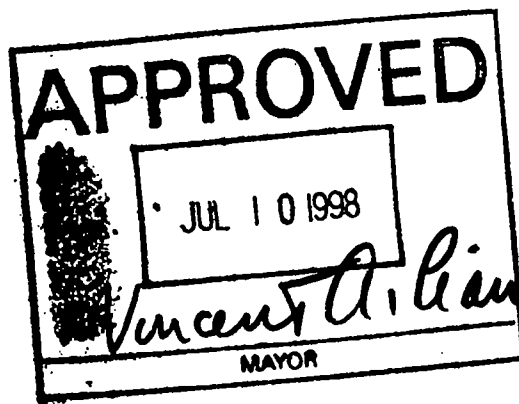
