That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled: "Providence, R.I. P.W. Dept. - Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan 0644552, Date: 10/22/93."

VIZ:

LEGG STREET, (portions of), shown as cross-hatched area on accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway. Said Abandonment is specifically conditioned precedent upon the following:

(1) Petitioner shall tender the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,850.00) in legal tender U.S. to the City of Providence.

(2) The petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the New England Telephone Company which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation. And it is further

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be place on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper, published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

The property located at 24 DePinedo Street uses this street, property, or land as an access to the property. I do not see this as a problem as there is also access from DePinedo Street.

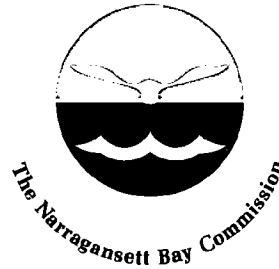
