RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 600

Approved June 22, 1979

RESOLVED, That The Providence City Council urges all citizens and all city and governmental agencies and employees thereof, and private industry and workers therein to make all efforts and take all steps possible to conserve fuel and energy. Among other things it strongly recommends the following:

1. Greater use of public transportation.
2. Placing all traffic lights on a blinking-traffic light system except during rush hours, and to make any other adjustments in the traffic light system which would permit automobiles to proceed under safe conditions without needlessly wasting gasoline when stopped at red lights where no traffic is coming from other directions, and other situations where relaxation of traffic regulations while maintaining safe conditions will conserve fuel.
3. Issuing awards and letters of commendation to citizens and city workers who make effective suggestions on ways to save fuel and energy.
