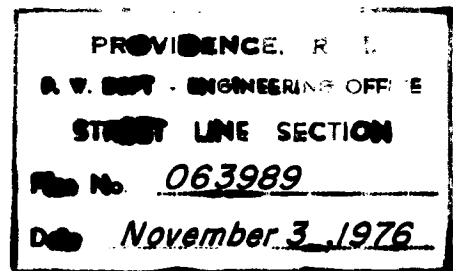
Gentlemen:

The Narragansett Electric Company presently has both underground and overhead electrical facilities located in this portion of Acorn Street. The overhead facilities consist of one pole with its associated cables to serve area homes. The underground facilities consist of a 12 way duct line together with distribution supply cables. This underground portion is an important tie between Harris Avenue Substation and the Federal Hill area, and the relocation of these facilities would be very difficult and extremely costly.

However, The Narragansett Electric Company will not object to the granting of said petition, provided that in the event the petition is granted, the Petitioner(s) will convey an easement acceptable to, and at no cost to, The Narragansett Electric Company which will permit the retention of said existing facilities in their present locations in said street, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same.

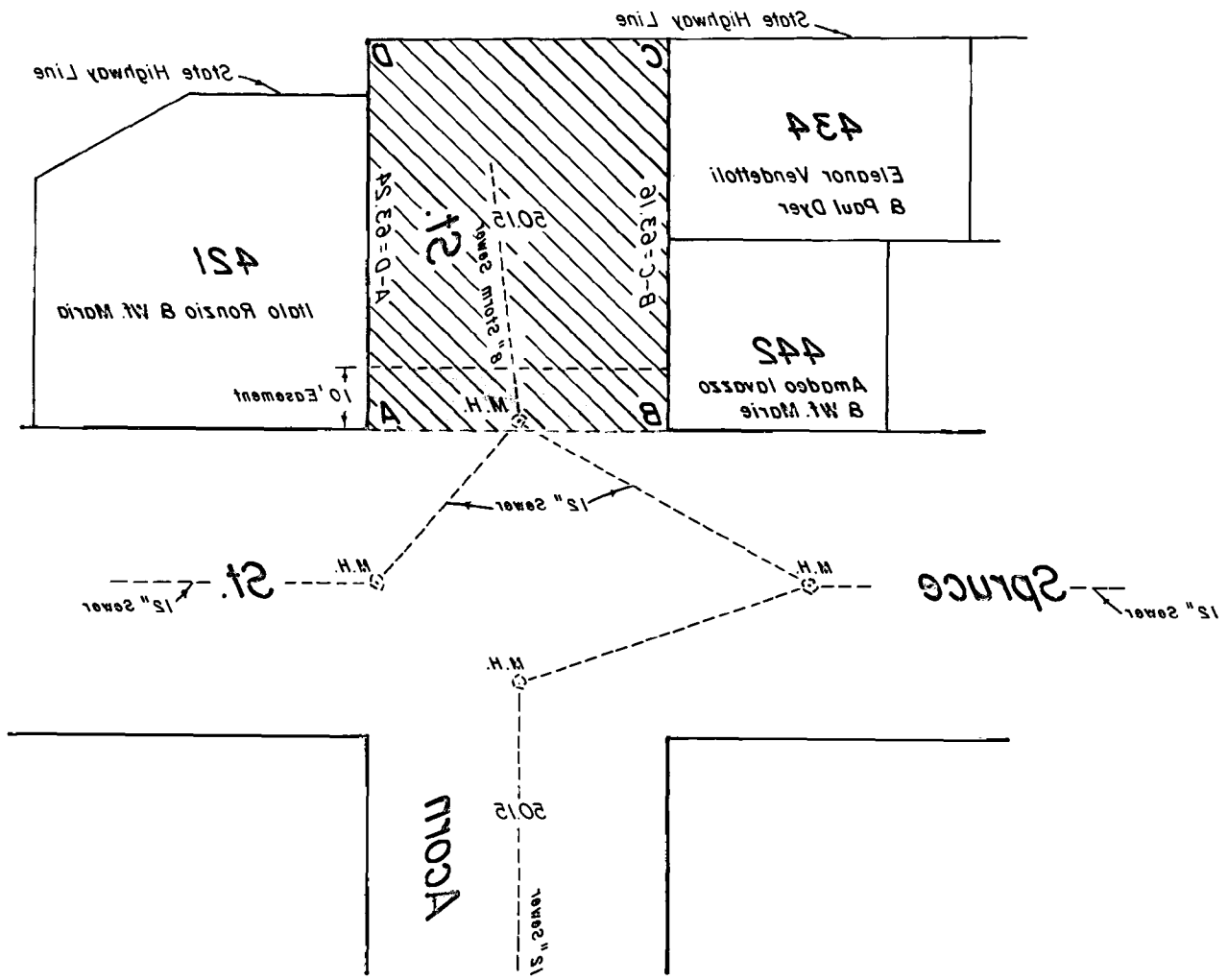
***Lot Numbers From Assessor's Plat 28***

THE DEAD END PORTION OF ACORN STREET FROM  
SPRUCE STREET TO ITS NORTHERLY TERMINATION

Dear Mr. Vespia:

In response to the petition from the Committee on Public Works, this Department has the following comments: A field inspection has revealed that the specified portion of Acorn Street extends from Spruce Street, a distance of approximately 63' to a dead end, and is located adjacent to a very busy pizza bakery. The inspection was made at early afternoon and revealed a crowded intersection with traffic coming from all directions. The portion of Acorn Street in question, was being utilized as a parking lot as part of a dead end street. It has no apparent value as a public highway, and can be easily converted to satisfy a parking scarcity.

On the basis of the above information, the City Plan Commission informally offered no objection to the proposed abandonment. This decision will be formally ratified at its next regular meeting.
