RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to prohibit Motor Vehicle Traffic along Thayer Street, from Waterman Street to George Street, on Friday, April 30, 1982, from 6:30 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M.; Meeting Street and Cushing Street, from Brook Street to Hope Street on Saturday, May 1, 1982, from 6:30 o'clock A.M. to 5:00 o'clock P.M.; and Charles Field Street, from Brook Street to Hope Street, on Sunday, May 2, 1982 from 12:00 o'clock Noon to 6:00 o'clock P.M., to accommodate the 1982 Spring Weekend Activities at Brown University.

1982 Spring Weekend activities at Brown University are planned for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, 29-30 April - 1-2 May 1982.

In connection with the weekend activities we request that a section of Thayer Street be closed to traffic on Friday, 30 April 1982, from 6:30 AM to 7:00 PM

The city block affected by the above request will involve Thayer St. from its intersection with Waterman St. to the intersection of Thayer St. and George St.

Granting this request will enable pedestrian traffic to move more freely and safely about the Hegeman/Caswell Courtyard area.

On Saturday, 1 May 1982, from 6:30 AM to 5:00 PM we request that the following city streets be closed to vehicle traffic, with the exception of people living in the immediate area, emergency vehicles and vehicles delivering supplies to the area:

1. Meeting St. from Brook St. to Hope St.
2. Cushing St. from Brook St. to Hope St.

This will allow pedestrian traffic to move about freely during the outdoor concert being held at Pembroke Field House.


