AN ORDINANCE in amendment of and in Addition to Chapter 1983-19 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence Approved May 3, 1983 and Entitled "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Trinity Gateway Revitalization Project" for Additional Parcel Controls.

Approved May 25, 1993

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

1. That Chapter 1983-19 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, approved May 3, 1983, and entitled, "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Trinity Gateway Revitalization Project" as amended by Chapter 1988-44 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, approved November 23, 1988 and as amended by Chapter 1990-30 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, approved December 26, 1990, be and the same is hereby further amended as follows:
 - A. Add the following Paragraph (h) after Paragraph (g) under Section 4 entitled "Miscellaneous Provisions" of Chapter G. entitled "Other Provisions Necessary to Meet Local Objectives" on pages 32 and 33 of that certain booklet entitled, "Trinity Gateway Revitalization Project" which is a part of the aforementioned Ordinance.
 - (h) Disposition Parcels 7A and 7B, as set forth on Map No. 5 entitled "Disposition Map" as amended, are located within the Pine Street Historic District. Parcel 7A is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Therefore, any proposed development project on Parcels 7A or 7A and 7B shall be reviewed by the Providence Historic District Commission as described in Chapter 1991-29 No. 564 of the Providence zoning Ordinance. This review shall be in lieu of review by the Rhode Island Historical Preservation Commission. Providence Historic District Commission's approval shall be required for any proposed development. The Providence Historic District Commission shall use its New Construction Guidelines in reviewing development proposals.

AN ORDINANCE

- B. Add the following paragraph after the last paragraph of Section 6 entitled "Duration and Effective Date of Regulations and Controls" in Chapter G. entitled "Other Provisions Necessary to Meet Local Objectives" on Pages 33 and 34 of that certain booklet entitled, "Trinity Gateway Revitalization Project" which is a part of the aforementioned Ordinance.

"After the date of approval of this Redevelopment Plan each and all plan amendments of this Redevelopment Plan relative to all conditions, restrictions and covenants running with the land shall be in full force and effect for a period of forty (40) years commencing on the date of each of its adoption by the City Council".

2. That said Chapter 1983-19 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence as adopted and as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects.
3. That this Ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy thereof to the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

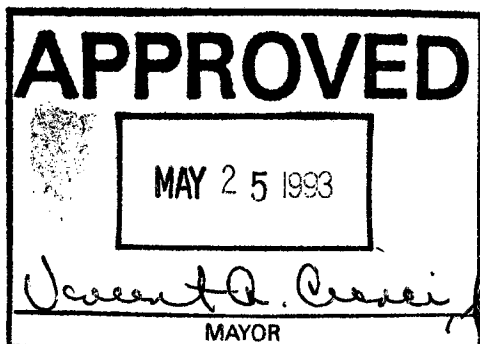


Enclosed is an original and twenty (20) copies of an Ordinance in Amendment to the Trinity Gateway Redevelopment Plan.
