RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved June 8, 1981

WHEREAS, there is currently pending litigation entitled "Mendillo v. Cianci, et al.", in the Superior Court of the State of Rhode Island;

WHEREAS, the Law Department, under Section 5.4 of the Providence Charter is charged with the responsibility of the defendants therein named in their official capacities;

WHEREAS, a conflict of interest has arisen, prohibiting that usual representation and thus mandating the withdrawal of the City Solicitor's Office as counsel for defendants;

WHEREAS, it remains necessary that the defendants obtain adequate representation once the City Solicitor's Office, because of the above-stated conflict, withdraws as attorneys for defendants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the City Council, the Finance Director of the City of Providence and the City Treasurer retain adequate counsel to represent them in their official capacities in the above-referred to law suit, pursuant to Section 2.8 of the Providence Charter.
