

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

*No.* 709

*Approved* December 29, 1997

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 797 of the City Council created a Committee on State Legislation on November 15, 1993, Resolution No. 25, approved January 27, 1997, extending the Committee on State Legislation, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of said committee was to track, monitor and testify on legislation affecting the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, Said Committee as established, is inconsistent with the Rules of the City Council adopted on January 2, 1995, and

WHEREAS, Rule 20 (c) of said Rules of the City Council adopted January 2, 1995, provides for the creation of all special committees of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, The City Council believes the tracking and monitoring of State Legislation and Testimony on State Legislation affecting the City of Providence is important to the future deliberations of the City Council and the welfare of the Citizens of Providence,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That pursuant to Rule 20 (c) of the Rules of the City Council, a Special Committee on State Legislation is hereby created, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Special Committee on State Legislation shall be charged with the responsibility of tracking and monitoring legislation and testifying before the legislature and its committees regarding all legislation proposed by the City Council and/or affecting the City of Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Special Committee shall consist of Five (5) Members of the City Council who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council pursuant to Rule 20 (c) of the Rules of the City Council, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the term of said Special Committee shall expire upon the final adjournment of the January, 1999 Session of the Rhode Island General Assembly.

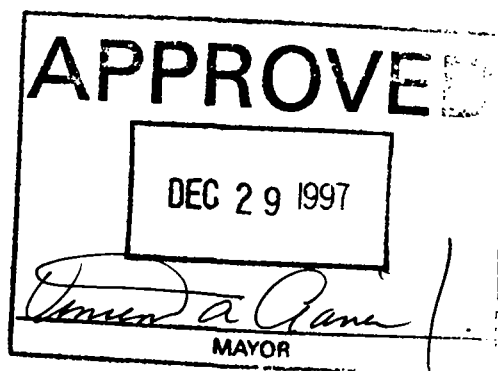

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 695

Approved December 30, 1996

WHEREAS, The Providence City Council is hereby requested to create a Committee on Recreation for the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, The said Committee would be in charge of the responsibility to meet with the Director of Recreation and his/her subordinates and Members of the Recreational Advisory Board, and

WHEREAS, This newly created Committee would meet in order that some concrete discussion would be made relative to the management and delivery of services to the Providence Taxpayer, and

WHEREAS, Rule 20 (c) of the said Rules of the City Council does hereby provide for the creation of all Special Committees of the City Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That pursuant to Rule 20 (c) of the Rules of the Providence City Council, a Special Committee on Recreation is hereby created. That the charge of said Special Committee shall meet with the Director of Recreation, subordinates and any other City Officials which it may deem necessary for the purpose of advising the City Council as to the proper management and delivery of services to the people of the City of Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Special Committee shall consist of five (5) Members of the City Council who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council or the Council President Pro Tempore pursuant to said Rule 20 (c) and that the term of said Special Committee shall expire on January 1, 1998.
