WHEREAS, By Patrolmen Harris and Conley attending monthly meetings in the Community, they have been welcomed by the residents and the businesses located in the area, and

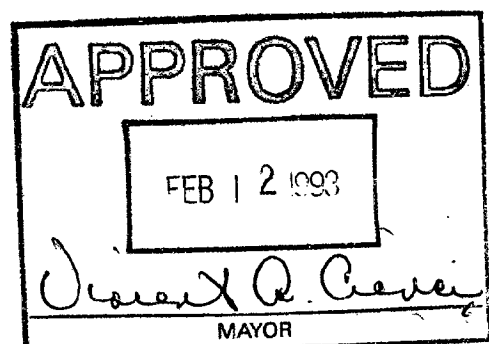

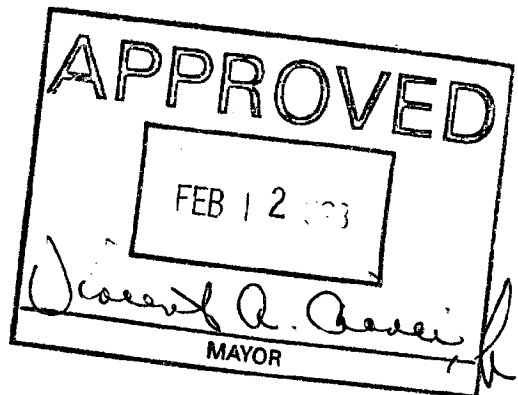

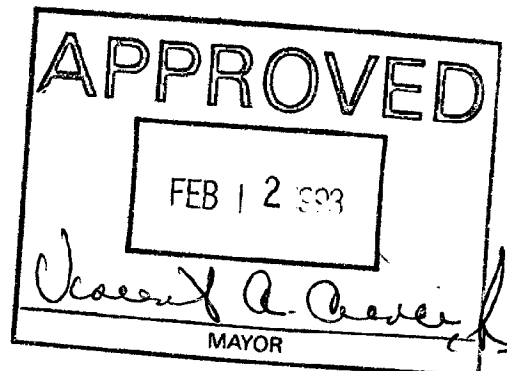
