In accordance with the Provisions of Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, I, the undersigned, hereby respectfully request you call a Special Meeting of the City Council on Tuesday, the 23rd Day of June, 1987 at 5:30 o'clock P.M.

The purpose of said meeting is for the City Council to consider the following matters, viz:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF 1987 TAXES IN A SUM NOT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO MILLION (\$122,000,000.00) DOLLARS AND NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$123,500,000.00) DOLLARS, BEING BASED ON ONE HUNDRED (100%) PER CENT OF THE 1987-1988 FISCAL YEAR TAX COLLECTION, AS AMENDED.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF TWO HUNDRED AND THREE MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS (\$203,545,892.00) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1988, AS AMENDED.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF EIGHTY-TWO MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS (\$82,168,118.00) FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE PROVIDENCE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1988, AS AMENDED.




