Dear David:

I directed Lou Colombo, Deputy Director of the Grounds Maintenance Division, to investigate the Hector Laudati sign at the Neutaconkanut Field. This is an issue which has arisen quite a few times and I hope we can resolve it permanently.

The sign to which you refer is on the back-stop where it has been for the past four years. If what the neighbors would like is a plaque of some sort, we would certainly be willing to place it in an area of their choosing. They should understand, however, that they would have to provide the information and text for review by the board of Park Commissioners. They would also have to provide funding for the plaque.

The Parks Commission meets on the first Tuesday of each month. However, they sometimes suspend meetings in the summer so it may not be possible to resolve this until September. Please let me know if this presents a problem to you.

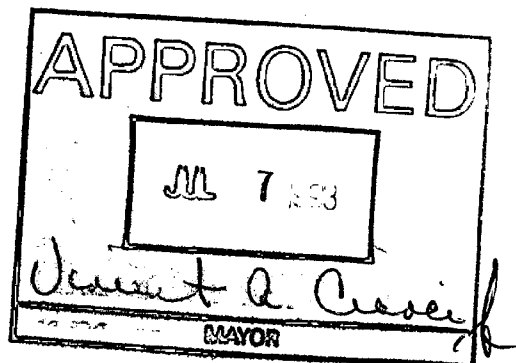
