Re: Year End Report

In December of 2005, the Providence Board of Canvassers converted to the Central Voter Registration System, implemented by the Secretary of State's Office. In January 2006, all active and inactive voter registration cards were scanned into the system so that the Boards of Canvassers would be able to view signatures and track registration cards.

For the first quarter, the Board of Canvassers processed 1,033 registrations, cancelled 32 and made voter requested changes to 515 records, as well as processing disaffiliations for potential candidates running in a particular party.

During the second quarter, the Board processed 458 declarations of candidacy and certified nomination papers for candidates running in the Primary. Additionally, the Board certified candidates to the Secretary of State to be placed on the ballot. In the second quarter there were 2,131 registrations processed, 62 cancellations and 3,792 voter requested changes made.

The Primary election took place during the third quarter and the Board of Canvassers processed 7,279 registrations, cancelled 139 and made voter requested changes to 3,341 records. After the Primary, the Board was responsible for tallying the election results for the City of Providence.

The General Election took place during the last quarter in which the Board of Canvassers processed 3,197 registrations, cancelled 38 and made voter requested changes to 5,521 records.
