WHEREAS, Downtown Providence suffers from inadequate traffic patterns and signalization.

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Development is working with the Commissioner of Public Safety, the Police Department, the Fire Department, the Department of Public Works and the Traffic Engineer in the reconfiguration of circulation in downtown Providence, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning & Development is working with downtown businesses, residents and property owners in the design of the necessary improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning & Development, with support from the aforementioned entities, has developed a traffic strategy that will reduce congestion and improve safety.

WHEREAS, in order to make said improvements, Chapel Street must become a one way street in an easterly direction;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council resolves that Chapel Street be a one way street, from Empire Street easterly to Snow Street and no further, in accordance with the plans set forth by the Department of Planning & Development and the requirements of the Department of Traffic Engineering.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents relative to the promulgation and implementation of the aforementioned activities.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
