


Gentlemen:

We have completed our investigation of the resolution requesting the installation of traffic signals at the intersection of Douglas Avenue and Eaton Street.

There is a substantial amount of traffic which feeds through this intersection especially during the rush hour. The major problem however, is the geometry. Eaton Street, Donelson Street and Camden Avenue all intersect with Douglas Avenue at this point, forming a complicated intersection which would be difficult to signalize to maintain a satisfactory movement of traffic.

However, we do not recommend the installation of traffic signals at this time. The location will be considered for the installation of flashing lights and included on our master priority list for future signalization.




