CHAPTER 934

No. 158 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 187.3
OF ARTICLE XV OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF PROVIDENCE 1946. RELATING TO SICK LEAVE
WITH PAY.

Approved March 4, 1955

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 187.3 of Article XV of the
Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence 1946, approved
March 5, 1951 and also designated as Sec. 3 of Chapter 455
of the 1951 Ordinances entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing
Sick Leaves with Pay for Certain City Employees" is hereby
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3. Sick leave with full pay for officers and
permanent employees subject to the provisions of this
Ordinance shall be 1½ working days per month. Such annual
sick leave of 15 working days with pay, when not used, shall
be cumulative, but the accumulated and unused portion of such
sick leave shall not exceed 90 days at any one time; provided,
however, any employee with at least ten (10) years of con-
tinuous service who contracts a serious illness may be granted,
with the approval of the Personnel Director, the Finance
Director and the Mayor, a further leave of ninety (90) days
in addition to his accumulated sick leave as of the date said
illness occurs.

CHAPTER 935

No. 159 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, 1946, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTRACT AND SUPPLY TO MAKE SETTLEMENTS FOR CITY LAND CONDEMNED BY THE STATE AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS, THE PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, THE PROVIDENCE HOUSING AUTHORITY, OR ANY OTHER PUBLIC BODY.

Approved March 4, 1955

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence, 1946, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended by adding after Sec. 31 thereof, the following section:

"SEC. 31. (a) The Board of Contract and Supply is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with the State of Rhode Island or the United States of America, the Providence Redevelopment Agency, the Providence Housing Authority or any other public body having authority to condemn property of the City with respect to the value of land owned by the City of Providence and taken by any of said agencies; and His Honor the Mayor is authorized to execute such deeds, releases and other documents as may be required by the condemnor or arising out of such condemnation."

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. 160 AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE
TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS AT A SPECIAL ELECTION, A REQUEST FOR APPROVAL
OF REDEVELOPMENT BONDS IN THE SUM OF \$2,500,000.

Approved March 4, 1955

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby requested
to submit the following question to the qualified electors of the
City of Providence at a special election to be held in the City of
Providence, viz.:

"Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue
bonds in a sum not exceeding two million five hun-
dred thousand (\$2,500,000) dollars for the Redevelop-
ment Revolving Fund authorized by the provisions of
Section 49 of Chapter 2574, Public Laws of Rhode Is-
land, A. D. 1950, in addition to two million (\$2,000,000)
dollars in bonds heretofore authorized under the provisions
of said act?"

SEC. 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit to the
Secretary of State forthwith upon the passage of this ordinance a certi-
fied copy thereof.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage,
and all ordinances and resolutions and parts of either, inconsistent here-
with are hereby repealed.
