# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, There is a crisis in energy and gasoline, both short term and long term, and

WHEREAS, This is creating great hardship to the voters of the City of Providence and taxpayers as well as those passing through, and

WHEREAS, Local committees have certain knowledge that would not be available at State National Levels on particular needs of the Community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council create a Special Committee to be Chaired by the Senior Member of said City Council, to hold a Public Hearing to obtain suggestions and to air proposals for energy saving within the City of Providence, including:

1. Blinking red lights except during rush hours;
2. Greater use of hydro-electric power in rivers;
3. Suggestions by City Employees;
4. Suggestions by School Employees;
5. Canadian Power Surplus; and
6. Nuclear Power.
