No. 430 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 2-99 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED, "AUTHORITY DELEGATED TO THE CITY SOLICITOR TO SETTLE SMALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY."

Approved September 9, 1974

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Creation of Authority. The City Solicitor shall have the authority and power delegated to him and his office to settle claims against the City for damages and injuries (due to, or occasioned by, the negligence of the City or any officer, agent, or employee of the City without the necessity of the approval of the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Claims and Pending Suits in claims or actions in litigation before the Courts not to exceed ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000) DOLLARS.)

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
