Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

This is to inform you that the Providence Redevelopment Agency at its March 18, 1981 meeting was advised of the above referred to resolution, and was also apprised that State enabling legislation and Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development rules and regulations precluded the expenditure of funds for maintenance within public rights-of-way.

However, it should be noted that the City's Department of Planning and Urban Development at the request of Mayor Cianci is coordinating maintenance activities within Cathedral Square with the Departments of City Property and Public Works, and that considerable work has already been completed and additional work is scheduled for early attention. Additionally, the Police Department has increased its surveillance of the area and will continue to undertake security measures.

I trust the present and proposed activity will assure the City Council that Cathedral Squares' problems are being addressed.
