

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved November 9, 1978

WHEREAS, During the 1978 Baseball Season and the Baseball World Series, one of the standouts was South Providence's own Davey Lopes, star second baseman for the Los Angeles Dodgers, Winner of the National League Penant, and
