Approved July 13, 1979

WHEREAS, A native of Rhode Island, she entered religious life at St. Xavier's Convent, sixty-three years ago, and

WHEREAS, Ever dedicated to her religion, she worked arduously and succeeded in the establishment of the first Chapel in a housing-for-the elderly which has been named in her honor, and

WHEREAS, Sister Dominica, having commenced her teaching career in 1918, became the first principal at St. Matthews School in Cranston, an honor well deserved, and

WHEREAS, Being the recipient of numerous awards, including an honorary membership in the Sisterhood of Temple Beth-Israel,
