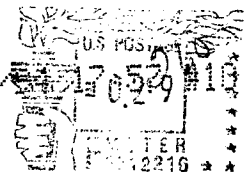

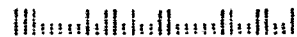



BROWN STREET - FROM BENEVOLENT STREET TO GEORGE STREET

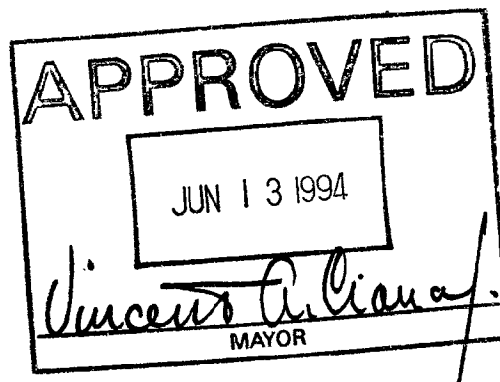
CHARLESFIELD STREET - FROM 37 CHARLESFIELD STREET (CONSTRUCTION GATE) to THAYER STREET.
