

RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to review the curb side parking restrictions, in place, on South Main , Benefit, College, George and Hopkins Streets in the area of the Frank W. Licht Judicial Complex and report to the Chairman of the City Council Committee on Public Works, in his Capacity as a member of the Traffic Engineering Advisory Committee, the following:

- a.) The number of curbside parking spaces that are currently reserved on the streets in that area;
- b.) Indicate the procedure under which windshield stickers authorizing parking in the restricted area were obtained and distributed;
- c.) Specify the number of pole signs indicating reserved parking in that area; indicate the reserved parking instructions on such signs; and
- d.) Specify by whom such signs were requested and by whom furnished.


