



# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 290

EFFECTIVE June 28, 2021

WHEREAS, The City of Providence has installed a number of various speed bumps, speed control measures and signage throughout the city over the past few months; and

WHEREAS, The residents of the City of Providence have expressed their concern regarding the recently installed speed control measures that reportedly have not been adequately adapted to the traffic needs of the city's neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, When installed properly, speed control measures and signage are critically important tools for making our city's streets safe for residents and visitors alike, which is why it is imperative that the design and implementation of such measures are properly vetted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council does hereby request that the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Traffic Engineer provide a comprehensive analysis and review of all speed control measures and signage installed in the last 12 months in the city.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said comprehensive analysis shall include the cataloging and mapping of all speed control measures throughout the city, the installation date for each measure, a description of the type of measure used, the cost of installation for each measure, and both pre and post-installation data regarding the impacts each speed control measure has on traffic.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council requests that within forty-five days of passage of this resolution, the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Traffic Engineer provide the City Council with the above described comprehensive analysis and report, as well as an implementation plan to immediately undertake all necessary steps to correct any identified deficiencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon passage, copies of this resolution be sent to the Mayor of Providence, the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Traffic Engineer.
