

WHEREAS, Motorists travel along Morris Avenue as an alternate route to Hope Street in excess of 35 miles per hour, resulting in numerous accidents,



We would like to ask your help in protecting the safety of our children and other pedestrians on Morris Ave.

As you probably know, this street is often used by motorists as an alternative route to Hope St. Consequently, cars which go through our residential area usually travel in excess of 35 mph. We are familiar with two fatal accidents in the past eight years.

To avoid any, God forbid, mishaps, we would like several stop signs placed at strategic corners: one before Brahman St., one at Savoy St. and one at Sessions St. We hope that this will deter excess traffic and slow down those cars that do travel Morris Ave.
