WHEREAS, Death has claimed the life of Joseph M. Halley, a native of Providence, at the age of Thirty-One, and


WHEREAS, A Marine Corps Veteran who served twice in Vietnam and who for the past Eighteen Months, resided and was employed in Los Angeles, California,
